the alberta and great waterways railway scandal was a political scandal in alberta, the royal commission reported months after rutherford had already resigned. justice beck's minority report was more sympathetic to all three men. beck declared himself perfectly satisfied that cushing, despite his protestations to the contrary, had been report of the hope commission, an ontario royal commission on education which reported in 1950, contained both an historical summary of the separate school controversy and a well documented refutation in the form of a dissenting minority report by the roman catholic members of the commission.
