

World Without End

The English town of Kingsbridge works to survive as the king leads the nation into the Hundred Years' War with France while Europe deals with the outbreak of the Black Death. *World Without End* offers a story taking off from the classic time machine and anticipating the post-apocalyptic nightmare of Planet of the Apes. It presents yet another version of what could be the future. The sets and complete production values are all fine and well realized. *World Without End* takes place in the same town of Kingsbridge, two centuries after the townspeople finished building the exquisite Gothic cathedral that was at the heart of the pillars of the Earth. The cathedral and the priory are again at the center of a web of love and hate, greed and pride, ambition and revenge, but this sequel stands on its own. *World Without End* is a best-selling 2007 novel by Welsh author Ken Follett. It is the second book in the Kingsbridge series, and is the sequel to 1989's *The Pillars of the Earth*. *World Without End* is an eight-episode 2012 television miniseries based on the novel of the same name by Ken Follett. It is a sequel to the 2010 miniseries *The Pillars of the Earth*, also based on a Follett novel. More than one science-fiction fan has noted the marked similarities between *World Without End* and H.G. Wells' *The Time Machine*. Hugh Marlowe plays Borden, the skipper of a quartet of astronauts.

Its sequel, *World Without End*, proved equally popular, and the Kingsbridge series has sold 38 million copies worldwide. The third book, *A Column of Fire*, will be published by Viking in fall 2017. Follett lives in Hertfordshire, England, with his wife Barbara. *World Without End* is the sequel to *The Pillars of the Earth*. However, it doesn't matter which you read first. The second book is set in the same town, Kingsbridge, but takes place two hundred years later, and features the descendants of the original characters.
